Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing just 4 people. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. Within 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is among the top international producers in the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. All through the last 60 years, the industry of material handling has grown into a really complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade at present continues to grow as the leader supplier of forklift attachments and various associated items. The company feels certain in their skill in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the international market.

In the 1950's, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and selling hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was finished in the year 1956 on a brand new office in order to house all the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total workers reached a hundred and eighty employees and sales had reached almost \$2,300,000.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are manufactured worldwide due to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of 5 companies, together with the international leader in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
